### Bylaws for

## Friends of the Wynnewood Public Library, Inc.

### ARTICLE I. MEMBERSHIP AND DUES

Categories of membership and dues shall be determined by the duly elected officers of the organization.

## ARTICLE II. MEETINGS

A bimonthly meeting shall be held at a time and place fixed by the duly elected officers of the organization.

### ARTICLE III. OFFICERS

The business, property, and affairs of this organization shall be managed by the duly elected officers of the organization. These consist of a President, Vice President, and Secretary/Treasurer. These are to be elected by the membership at the January meeting.

## ARTICLE IV. DUTIES OF OFFICERS

Section 1. The <u>President</u> shall preside at all meetings of the organization and shall have general supervision of the affairs of the organization. The President shall be an ex-officio member of all committees.

Section 2. The <u>Vice-President</u> shall assume the duties of the President in their absence.

Section 3. The <u>Secretary/Treasurer</u> shall take the minutes of all meetings and keep an accurate record of all business transacted. They shall be the custodian of all moneys and shall deposit them in the bank and the Secretary/Treasurer shall disburse the same only upon order of the membership. The Secretary/Treasurer shall present financial statements at regular meetings and keep complete organizational accounts.

#### ARTICLE V. COMMITTEES

The President may appoint such committees as are necessary for carrying out the activities of the organization.

## ARTICLE VI. AMENDMENTS

These bylaws may be amended at any meeting by a majority vote of the members present and voting; PROVIDED that notice of the proposed amendment is included in the notice of the meeting.

# ARTICLE VII. ELECTIONS OF TAX STATUS

The Officers of the Corporation may, form time to time, make such elections of tax status under the United States Internal Revenue Code and the Oklahoma Tax Code as are appropriate and in the best interests of the Corporation and no tin violation of the Articles of Incorporation, provided that no such election shall be made which forfeits the tax-exempt status of the Corporation.

### ARTICLE VIII. REVISED BYLAWS

These revised and updated bylaws were voted on and approved by a vote of the membership on Friday, August  $5^{\rm th}$ , 2022, and supersede any and all previous bylaws.
